Submission of applications, course of competition

1. The competition shall take place in Swimming pool “Vilija” (25 meter pool with 6 lanes) of Kaunas swimming school (LTU) (34 Demokratu str., Kaunas, LT 48421, Lithuania) in May 10-11, 2019.
2. The organisers of the competition shall be Kaunas swimming school and Kaunas swimming club „Delfinas“.
3. We kindly ask to inform us about your participation until 29 April 2019.
4. Technical applications shall be submitted until 6 May 2019, 5 PM.

5. All applications shall be submitted only by email [**vilija@swim.lt**](mailto:vilija@swim.lt)
6. Applications, submitted after the deadline, **shall not be accepted.**
7. The application shall be considered to be accepted if you have received a positive reply.
8. The last modifications are possible to be made until 9 May 2019, 1PM.
9. Fulfilled applications shall be sent to Kaunas swimming school by putting the file name of your team name (e.g., Kauno PM „Dainava“, Vilniaus SM...)
10. The athletes shall put in the technical application their best results achieved during the year (from 1 September 2018 until 6 May 2019).
11. Competition shall be personal / team based.
12. The competition shall take place according to the rules of FINA.
13. The participation fee (except KPM and Kauno SM “Startas”) shall be 5 EUR. For the invoice, it should be asked in advance.
14. The composition of the team shall be not more than 30 athletes (except KPM). Once the number of participants reaches 300, the organizers of the competition have the right to limit the number of participants in the competition.
15. The participant may swim 2 events in a day and 1 relay. Relay is made from 1 girl and 1 boy from each age group (younger athletes may swim for the older group).
16. Each participating organization may register more than one team in relay.
17. The team leader shall be responsible for the health state of each team member.
18. During the competition the organizers shall not be deemed responsible for the injuries of participants and for thefts.
19. During the competition the internal rules of the swimming pool shall be applied.
20. The chief judge of the competition shall be Rasa Duškinienė, and the chief secretary - Ieva Kuodytė.
21. All the expenses shall be paid by the sending organization or by the participants themselves.

Award

The first three swimmers in each event and age group will be awarded with medals and diploma, in relays - three first teams will be awarded with cups only.

Team Points : first place – 12 pts., second place – 10 pts., third place – 8 pts.,tenth place – 1 pt.

Final statements

The competition is a public event that can be filmed, photographed. Filmed or photographed material is posted in the media or on the Internet. Team leaders are responsible for timely submission of application. Participants are responsible for their own safety and proper behavior during trips, competitions and leisure time.
