REGULATIONS

I TIME AND PLACE

1. Pace: 50 m pool (Naujoji g. 52) in Alytus.
2. Time: 20–21 of April, 2018.
3. Beginning of competition:
 - 3.1. 20 April (Friday) 15:00 - **DAY I** (warm-up – 14:00)
 - 3.2. 21 April (Saturday) 10:30 - **DAY II** (warm-up – 9:30)
4. Entrance to the pool – 30 min. Before the beginning of warm-up.

II PARTICIPANTS

5. The competition is open.
6. The number of team members is unlimited.
7. Age:
 - 7.1. EYOF 2019 age group: girls, born 2004-2005 (13-14 years old) and boys, born 2003-2004 (14-15 years old)
 - 7.2. EYOF 2021 age group: girls, born 2006-2007 (11-12 years old) and boys, born 2005-2006 (12-13 years old)
8. Date, time and programme are subject to change.

III ENTRIES

9. Entries deadline – 4th of April, 2018, entries must be sent by email: **lpf.paraiskos@gmail.com**
10. Technical entries must be submitted no later than 14:00, 13th of April, 2018 (after the confirmation, the lenex file will be sent).
11. Changes/withdrawals are allowed until 6:00, 8th of April. No changes will be accepted after the deadline.
12. From the entries, submitted until 14:00, 13th of April, the events are allowed to be withdrawn but cannot be changed.
13. Entries must hold doctors’ visas allowing participation in competition. Team leaders are responsible for the valid allowances.
14. The results must be achieved in the competition of at least sport’s school.
15. Entries must be submitted using “Entry Editor“.
16. The submission must include: result (in case of no result - NT), pool length, date, city (not the title of the event). The results must be achieved from 01-01-2017 to 13-04-2018.
17. The completed application forms (entries) must be named after the team (i. e., Kauno PM, Vilniaus VCM).

20. No entries will be accepted after the deadline.
21. Entries are considered to be accepted after a confirmation (reply) is received.
22. The swimmers, whose achieved results mismatch with the results from the technical entry, will start with the mark “no result”.

V COMPETITION AND AWARDS

23. FINA rules are applied.
24. The timing system will be used.
25. Before entering the race, the participant must register at the participants' judge in the call room. In case of not showing up, the participant will not be allowed to participate in the event.
26. The competition is held with heats. Then, according to 2 age groups, the best participants will assigned to the finals: EJOE 2019 and EJOE 2021.
27. Events with 8 participants or less will be held as finals.
28. For the finals, 2 reserve names will be announced, they must come to the participants' meeting point.
29. The written withdrawal forms from the final must be handed to the secretary no later than 15 min after announcing the results.
30. The first three swimmers in each event will be awarded with medals and diplomas of the Lithuanian Swimming Federation.
31. Top male and female athletes in their age groups, based on the highest results according to FINA points (after summing up the totals of two events' rankings (only in individual events) **will be awarded with 100 € each.**
32. If two or more swimmers collect the same amount of FINA points in three events, the winners will be announced according to the ranking he has in the first event (second, etc.).

33. If the athlete misses the award ceremony, he/she will not receive the prize.

VI PROTESTS

34. Protests are allowed only against violations of competition rules and regulations as well as in situations where the competition or participants are endangered.

35. All protests must be submitted in writing with deposit of 50 Euro no later than 30 min after the violation.

36. Meet's board of appeal will process protests according to the Fina rules.

37. In case of granted protest, deposit will be returned.
