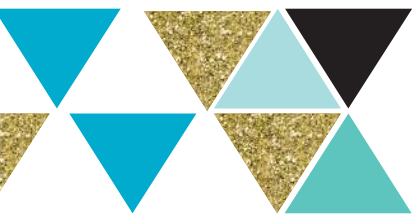

The competition will take place at Eriksdalsbadet in Stockholm, in a 50 m 10 lane pool. This four-day meet offers a full competition program which gives all competitors the best opportunities for qualification or preparation for the upcoming World Championships in Fukouka, World University Games in Chengdu, EYOF in Banska Bystrica and the European Championships in Rome. Compete with top swimmers from worldwide with the total prize money of € 38 000.

Temporary competition rules Swim Open Stockholm 2022

By reasons of the current and possible restrictions connected with the Covid-19 situation the Swim Open organization has already now decided that some temporary regulations will be applied for participation at Swim Open 2022. This is to ensure an infection prevention and safe arrangement for all participants.

Swim Open Stockholm reserve the rights to maximize to a total of 500 participants, of which 250 will be prioritized foreign participants.

Pre Entry: A participation at Swim Open Stockholm 2022 requires a Pre Entry. Each participant in the teams Pre Entry Form need to have a qualification by a standard time in at least one event. In the Pre Entry Form you attach each participants best qualified time inside the qualification period. **Last day for the Pre Entry Form is 2022-01-14** and be mailed to: management@swimopenstockholm.se. Pre Entry is of course free of charge. The official participant list will be presented 2022-01-21. All participants are then ranked by FINA points for their agegroup. The 500 participants with the highest ranking from foreign/swedish priorities will be allowed to attend. Additionally none qualified events for a participant are a subject to availability.

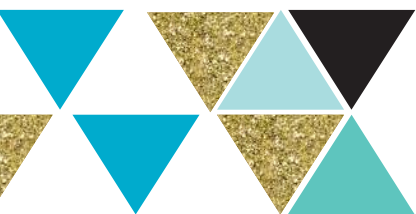
Accommodation: Also 2022 it's crucial that we can implement an infection prevention arrangement like we did 2021. Therefore all teams need to stay at the Clarion Stockholm where we can ensure a safe environment regarding meals and accommodation. Last day for booking accommodation is **2021-01-26**.

Swim Open Bubble: Depending on the situation in the future may require a presentation of a negative Covid-19 test for participation. If necessary a test center on spot like we had during Swim Open 2021 will be. We will probably also require mouth guard and other wise measures. More information about this will be presented closer to the event when we can overview the status.

Other: Depending on the future situation around Covid-19 and if we get new updated guidelines or restrictions other decisions may be necessary like a reduced event or restricted foreign participations. If so we inform you asap.

Cancellation: If there will be a total cancellation of Swim Open Stockholm 2022 the Sweden Swimming Federation cover all costs for the teams booked accommodation. Otherwise the cancellation policy in the invitation applies for accommodation.

Currently there are no restrictions connected to Covid-19 in Sweden for the event and we don't see that will come during 2022. But if some regulations will be applied later on connected to restrictions for the competition we will announce immediately at www.swimopenstockholm.se and to all registered team.

Location: Eriksdalsbadet, 50 m pool, 10 lanes (finals 8 lanes)

Rules: The competition will be conducted under FINA rules and is approved as a qualifying event to all international events.

Prel. competition times: Heats: 9.30, A-finals: 18.00 B- & C-finals: 16.30.

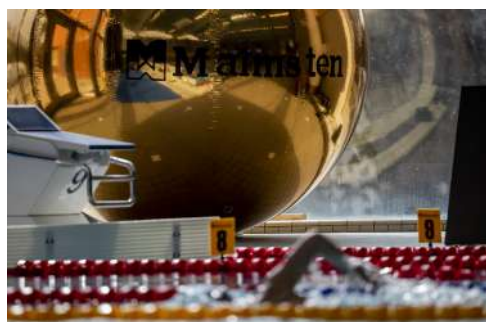
Warm up: 08.00 – 09.15 and 14.30 – 16.15 in the competition pool 25 m pool from 08.00 – end of competition, in selected lanes.

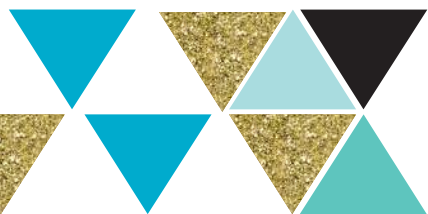
Entries: Closing date for entries is 15th of March 2022.

Qualification period: 2020-01-01 to 2022-03-13 in 25m or 50m pool. Entry times from 50 m pools will be seeded ahead of times from 25 m pools. In the 800 & 1500 freestyle 25 m times will be converted to 50 m times.

Qualifying times: A swimmer qualified in one event will be given the opportunity to compete in more events if space allows

Late entries:

Late entries will be accepted up until the team leader meeting at the cost of € 40/event and only if heat limitations do not apply.

Withdrawals:

Withdrawals for prelims and timed finals Saturday should be made Friday 8 pm at the latest. All other days no later than 30 minutes after the end of the finals of the previous day. Withdrawals to finals no later than 30 minutes after end of the event in the prelims.

Accreditation:

€20/accreditation, all swimmers and team staff need accreditation. Applications will be found at www.swimopenstockholm.se

Prize money:

Prize money in each event is as follows:
First place € 400, Second place € 200, Third place € 100.

The top three female and male performances, (counted on the three best results from FINA's table) gets prize money:

First place € 4 000
Second place € 2 000
Third place € 1 000.

Total prize money for the competition is €38 000

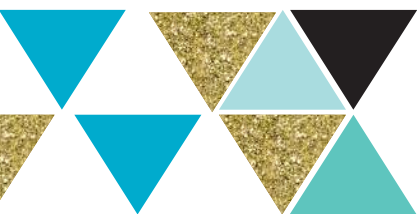
